STOCKHOLDER COMMUNICATION POLICY

Stockholders and other interested parties wishing to communicate with the Board of Directors, or any individual member of the Board of Directors, of Tableau Software, Inc. (the “*Company*”) regarding any matter, other than concerns or complaints about the Company’s accounting, internal controls, or auditing matters, should communicate with the Board of Directors or such director as follows:

1. The communication should be addressed to the director with whom communication is desired (or to the Lead Director if the communication is directed to the entire Board of Directors) as follows:

2. Any communication sent must state the number of shares owned by the person making the communication, if any.
3. The Company’s General Counsel will review each communication. The General Counsel will forward such communication to all of the members of the Board of Directors or to the individual director(s) to whom the communication is addressed unless the communication is unduly frivolous, hostile, threatening or similarly inappropriate, in which case, the General Counsel may discard the communication in his or his discretion.

Any concerns or complaints about the Company’s accounting, internal controls or auditing matters should be submitted in compliance with the Company’s Policy for Reporting Complaints Regarding Accounting and Auditing Matters.
