To transfer tickets, fans simply login to their "My Ticketmaster" account on www.ticketmaster.com. Fans click the order number of the tickets they wish to transfer and the "Transfer Tickets" button. Finally, the fan enters the name and email address of each recipient and selects which tickets to transfer.

To receive the tickets, the recipient will click "Accept Tickets" in the ticket transfer email Ticketmaster sends. The receiving fan will then sign into "My Ticketmaster" or create an account if they do not have one, enter the delivery method, and the tickets are transferred.
