Summary: CPUC PG&E Electrical Incident El220905A - On September 5, 2022 at 1402 hours, the Peabody 2105 21kV primary overhead distribution circuit experienced a sustained outage affecting 5870 customers. The outage was caused by a common neutral wrapping around the primary conductor in the area of Leisure Town Road and Denton Street in Vacaville, a non-HFTD. The portion of Peabody 2105 conductor involved in the incident is suspended over train tracks. It is believed the common neutral was struck by a passing train, causing it to wrap around the primary conductor. This incident resulted in a small vegetation fire that was contained to less than a quarter acre. All 5870 customers were restored by 1531 hours. PG&E received four reputable media inquiries into this incident within six hours of the initial outage. This incident is being reported under the media criterion. This information is preliminary.
