Summary: CPUC PG&E Electrical Incident - EI220810A - On August 10, 2022 at 1540 hours, a PG&E troubleman was dispatched to a reported structure fire in the vicinity of Filbert Avenue and Sheridan Avenue in Chico, a Non-HFTD. The area is served by the Chico A 1102 12 kV Primary Overhead Distribution Circuit. The fire appeared to have start in the attic of the home, causing damage to the roof and interior of the residence. On August 30, 2022, PG&E received notice of a potential claim related to the fire. The notice alleges that the fire was caused by a failure of PG&E equipment. This information is being reported under the Property Damage criterion due to damage likely to exceed \$50,000. This information is preliminary.
