Summary: CPUC PG&E Electric Incident EI220329A On January 22, 2024, PG&E Law-Claims received a claim regarding an incident that allegedly occurred in the area of 5th Street and Biggs Willows Road in Willows, of Glenn County, a non-HFTD. The area is served by the Willows A 1104 12kV overhead distribution circuit. The claim alleges that on March 29, 2022, a third-party individual was injured after being struck in the head by a cut power line. On January 24, 2024, Law-Claims was informed that the individual was admitted to the hospital for treatment. This incident is being reported under the injury criterion.
