



Flotation Operator

Northern Sun Mining Corp. is currently accepting applications for the contract position of Flotation Operator at the Redstone Mill.

The successful candidate's primary responsibilities will include:

- Daily contact with junior and senior mill staff to review operations and problems arising throughout the flotation circuit including mill and offsite;
- Daily contact with Production and Maintenance Supervisor to discuss maintenance requirements and problems to ensure minimal interruption to the operation;
- Responsible for adhering to company policy and legislated policies;
- Logs inspection and housekeeping reports of the flotation circuit;
- Produces an hourly (or as needed) detailed chemical dosage report and shift report summarizing major events and production results;
- Conducts daily information exchange throughout the shift and with their respected cross shift;
- Ensures all mobile equipment reports are completed prior to usage including but not limited to: 10 Mt & 5 Mt overhead crane, forklift, skid steer, scissor lift, man lift, loaders, etc.;
- Assists in accident/incident investigations and reporting when requested by the Mill Supervisor;
- Records time sheet every shift including the 5 point safety card;
- Maximizes tonnage throughput, recoveries and final concentrate grades within the flotation circuit;
- Ensures shift compliment/coverage is met;
- Additional tasks as assigned by the Mill Supervisor.

Qualifications:

- Minimum grade 12 education, post-secondary education in Mineral Processing or related field is highly regarded;
- Minimum 1 year of flotation experience is preferred;
- Mill Common Core with specialty modules U3359, U3377, U3384, U3385, U3390, U3393, U3399, U3401, U3404, U3407 and U3408 highly regarded;
- Sound knowledge of base metal processes;
- Computer literate (word and excel);
- Effective communication skills.
