Logitech to Announce Preliminary First Quarter Fiscal 2015 Results

NEWARK, Calif. & LAUSANNE, Switzerland--(BUSINESS WIRE)-- Logitech International (SIX:LOGN) (Nasdaq:LOGI) today announced that it will release preliminary unaudited quarterly financial results on Wednesday, July 23, 2014 at 10:00 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time and Thursday, July 24, 2014 at 04:00 Central European Summer Time. Due to an ongoing Audit Committee investigation, and because the Company has not yet filed its Form 10-K for Fiscal Year 2014, these first quarter financial results will be presented as preliminary.
