## Logitech Shareholders Approve Recommendations, Including Dividend, at Annual General Meeting

LAUSANNE, Switzerland--(BUSINESS WIRE)-- Logitech International (SIX: LOGN) (Nasdaq: LOGI) announced that at its annual general meeting held here today, the Company's shareholders approved a dividend of CHF 0.21 per share. Logitech shareholders eligible for the dividend must purchase the shares by the close of trading on Sept. 11, 2013 on the SIX Swiss Exchange or the Nasdaq Global Select Market. The shareholders approved all other recommendations put before them.
