

Oracle 2018 Political Contributions



Dear Stockholder,

Oracle Corporation, our stockholders, and our employees are directly impacted by public policy decisions made at all levels of government in the United States and around the world. Oracle conducts business in more than 175 countries, necessitating compliance with a complex web of international laws governing our operations. Proposed policy changes, such as those affecting intellectual property rights, taxation, and international trade, can have an impact on Oracle's bottom line and stockholder value. Oracle believes it is necessary and appropriate to engage in the political process to further the long-term interests of the company and our stockholders.

Transparency. Oracle recognizes that stockholders are interested in disclosure regarding corporate spending on US political activities. Although Oracle's level of activity in this area is relatively low, in the interest of transparency we are providing this report in addition to what is mandated by the extensive political disclosure laws governing our activities. This report and subsequent updates will be provided to the Finance and Audit Committee of the Oracle Board of Directors and will be available on our website.

Oversight. Oracle is committed to the highest ethical standards, and we have procedures in place to ensure that our political contributions are subject to appropriate oversight and in the best interest of stockholders. Oracle's public policy agenda is developed and advanced by Oracle's Government Affairs department, which focuses its efforts on public policy issues that are relevant to the long-term interests of Oracle. Oracle's Government Affairs department reports to one of Oracle's CEOs, who oversees the group's activities. All political contributions are intended to promote the long-term interests of Oracle and are made without regard to the personal political preferences of Oracle's executives.

Disclosure. Oracle's government relations practices comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and disclosure requirements. Oracle's political activities in the US are monitored by Oracle's Public Sector Legal & Compliance group, which reports directly to Oracle's General Counsel. Oracle's federal lobbying disclosure reports to the secretary of the US Senate and the clerk of the US House of Representatives are publicly available at their respective websites: https://www.senate.gov/legislative/Public_Disclosure/LDA_reports.htm and http://clerk.house.gov/public_disc/index.aspx.

Oracle made no expenditures for express advocacy or electioneering communications reportable under applicable laws.

Oracle PAC. As part of Oracle's commitment to improve the public policy environment, Oracle employees came together in 1996 to form our own nonpartisan political action committee, Oracle PAC. Oracle PAC enables eligible Oracle employees and stockholders to support elected officials who share our vision for innovation, competitiveness, regulation, and economic growth. Oracle PAC is a voluntary fund that is separate from Oracle Corporation and operates in compliance with federal laws governing PAC activities. Oracle PAC is managed by a steering committee that consists of Oracle PAC donors and Oracle Government Affairs personnel. All Oracle PAC donors are welcome to recommend potential recipients of Oracle PAC contributions, and all contributions are approved by the steering committee before disbursements are made. Records of Oracle PAC's Federal Election Commission (FEC) reports, which detail contributions and expenditures, are publicly available on the FEC website www.fec.gov.
