The Bank is chartered by the State of California, and its deposits are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, or FDIC, to the maximum extent permitted by law. The Bank conducts its banking business from its main office in Los Angeles, California, and through twelve full-service branch banking offices in California (Alhambra, Century City, City of Industry, Torrance, Arcadia, Irvine (2), Diamond Bar, Pico Rivera, Tarzana and San Francisco (2)), two branches in New York (Manhattan and Flushing, Queens) and a branch office in the Houston, Texas suburb of Sugar Land. In addition, the Bank also operates a loan production office in Sunnyvale, California. Preferred Bank offers a broad range of deposit and loan products and services to both commercial and consumer customers. The Bank provides personalized deposit services as well as real estate finance, commercial loans and trade finance to small and mid-sized businesses, entrepreneurs, real estate developers, professionals and high net worth individuals. Although originally founded as a Chinese-American Bank, Preferred Bank now derives most of its customers from the diversified mainstream market but does continue to benefit from the significant migration to California of ethnic Chinese from China and other areas of East Asia.

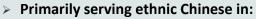

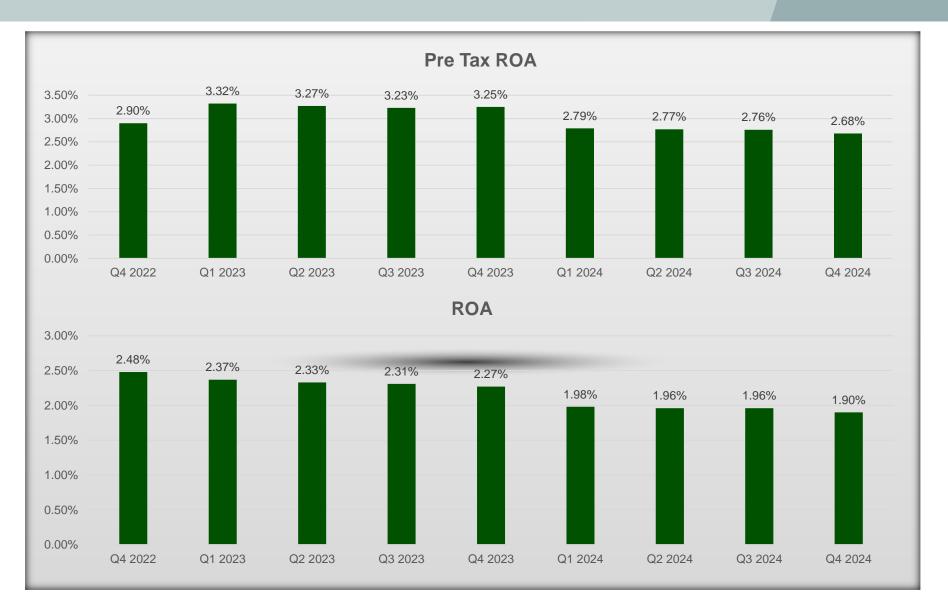






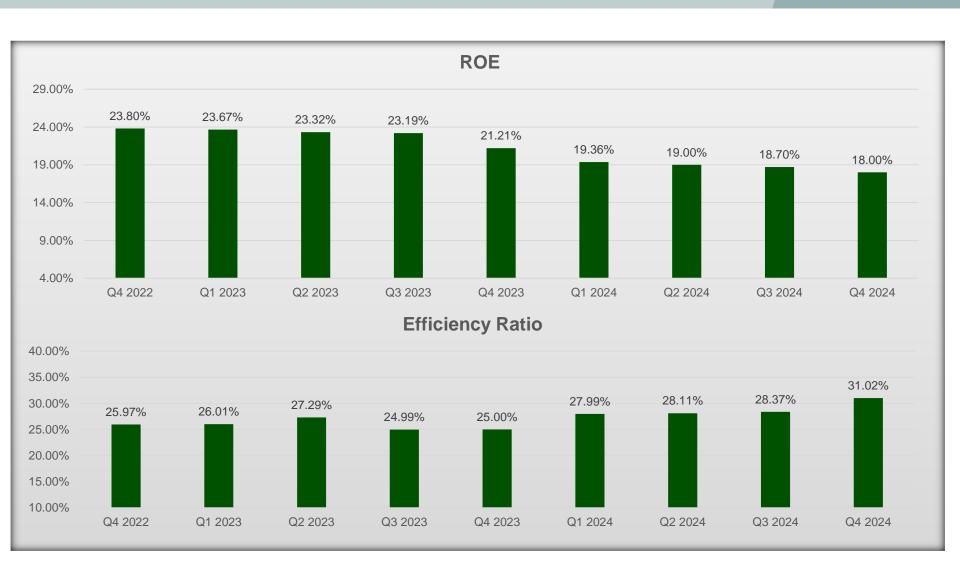

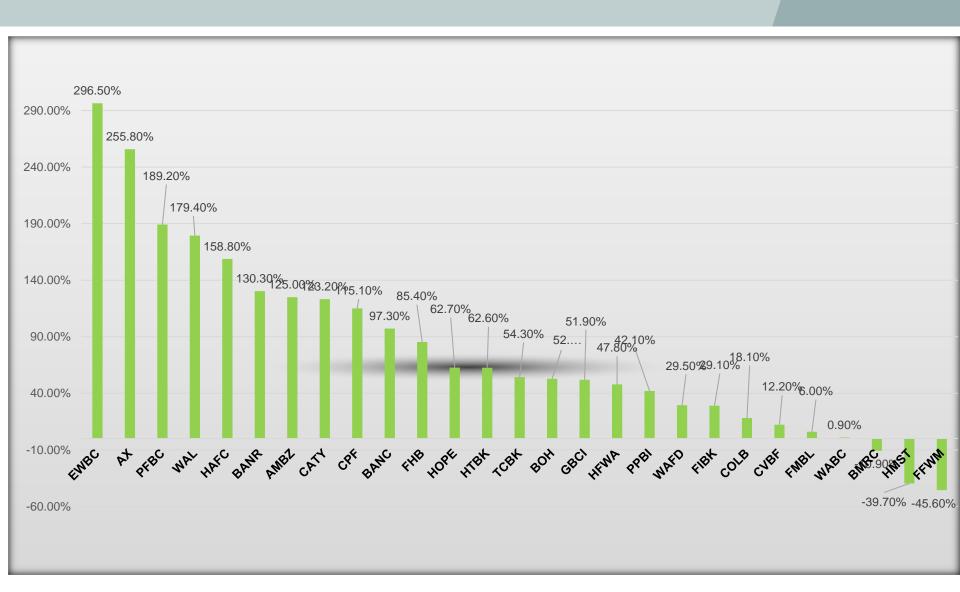
Consistent Loan and Deposit Growth.....





5-Year Total Return vs S&P West Banks > \$5bb

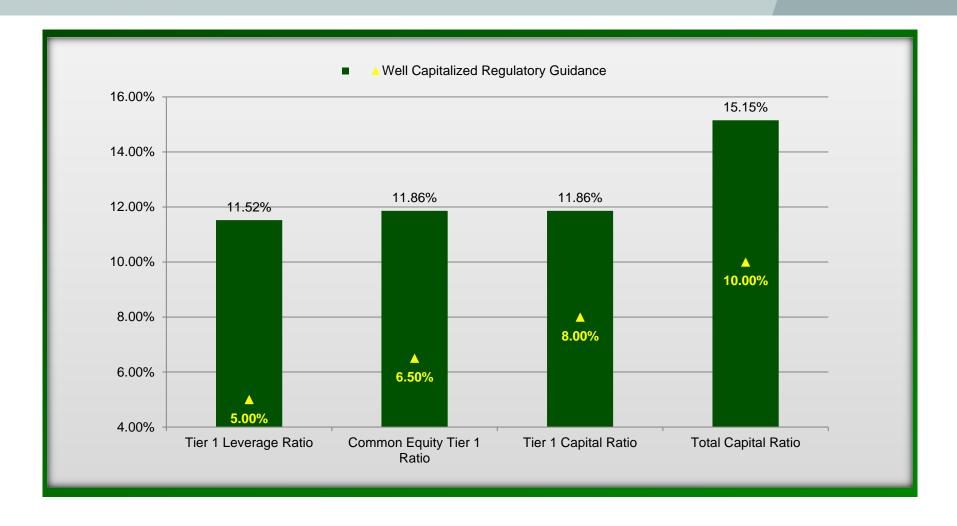






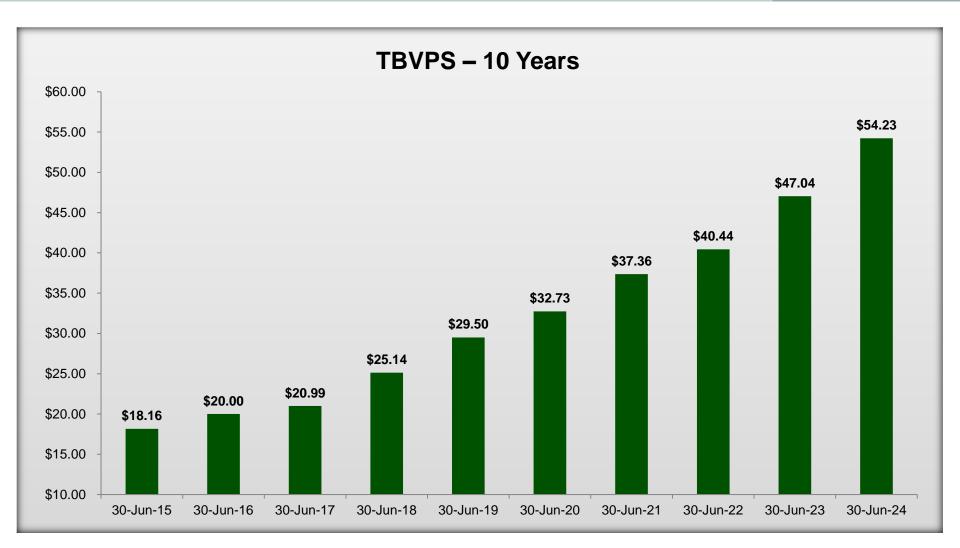
Capital Ratios – March 31, 2025

CAGR of 12.6% Over the Last Ten Years -- Current TBV is \$59.27

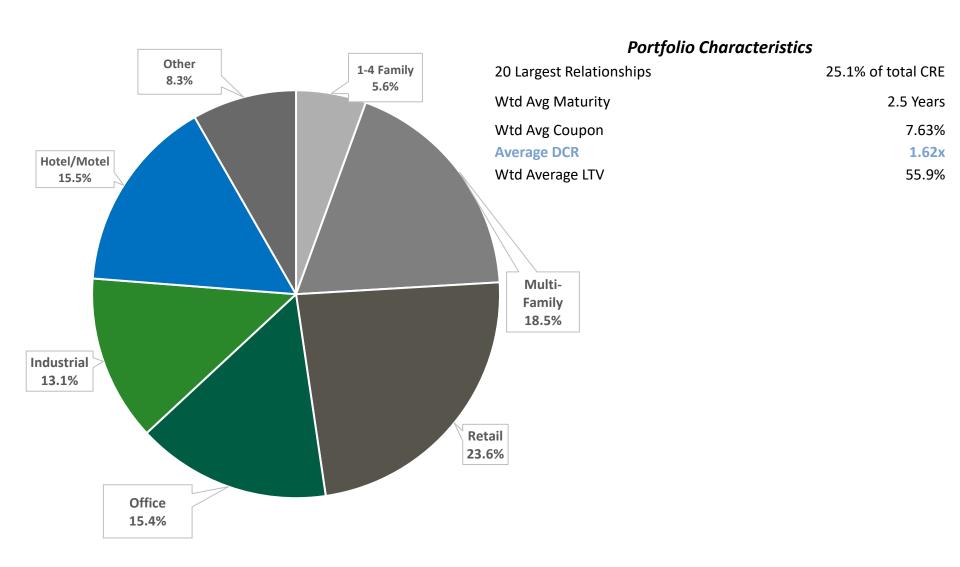


Loan Portfolio Composition – March 31, 2025

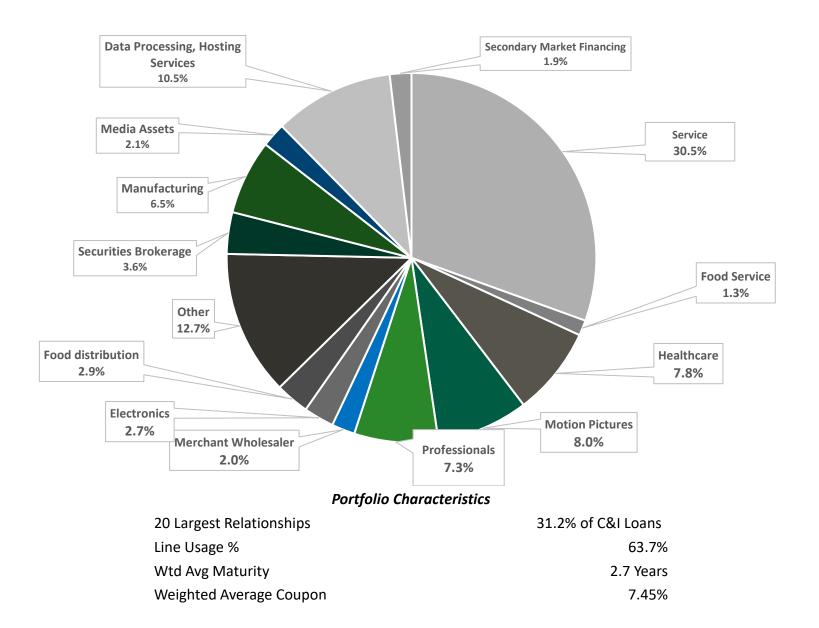

Real Estate Loan Portfolio – March 31, 2025

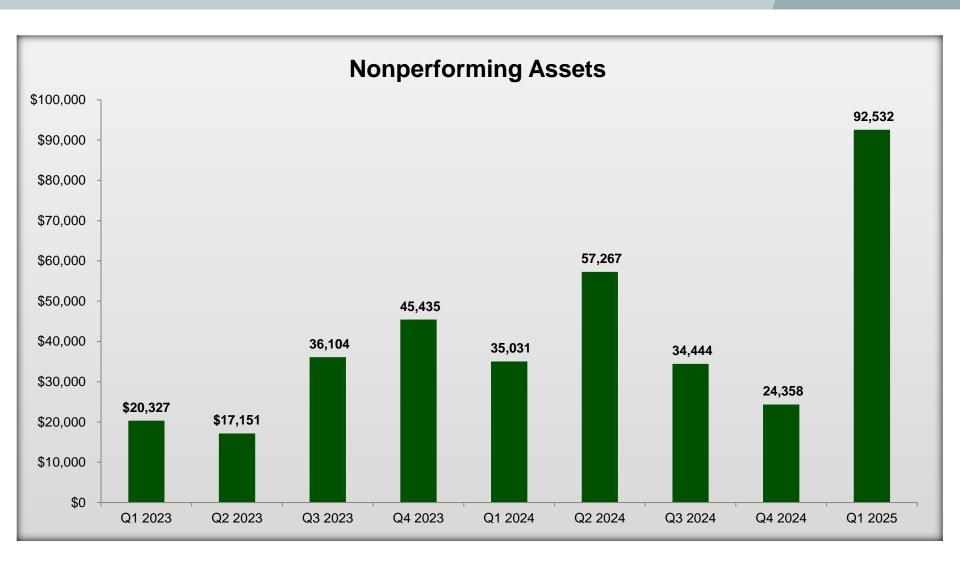


C&I Portfolio Detail – March 31, 2025

Recent Developments – NPL's

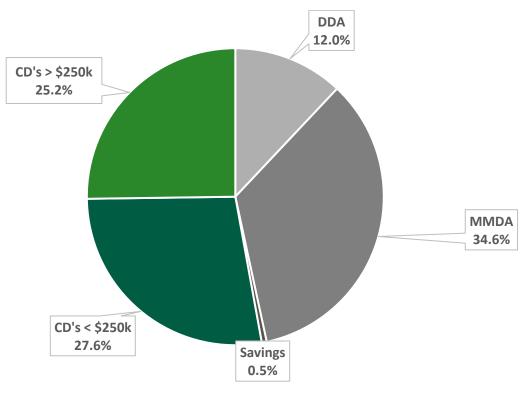


- In the Q1 2025 Earnings Press Release and on the ensuing earnings call, the Bank discussed two relatively large credits that had migrated to nonaccrual status.
 - One loan (\$28.5mm) is secured by what is now vacant land in a prime location in Newport Beach, California. The Bank has already received a large non-refundable deposit for the sale of the note, at par.
 - The other loan is a \$36.9mm loan secured by a large multi-family property in Redlands, California. This loan has an LTV of 71% based on a late 2024 appraisal. This property is part of a BK filing and offers have been received for this property for just under \$50mm.
- In light of the above, the Bank does not expect to incur any losses on these two nonperforming loans.

Recent Expansion



- On April 7, 2025, the Bank opened a full-service Branch office In Manhattan, NY in the prestigious Penn 2 building at Penn Station.
- In May of 2024, the Bank opened a Loan Production Office in the Silicon Valley community of Sunnyvale, California.
- The Bank is currently in negotiations with the owner of a retail property in Cupertino, California with the intent to move the LPO to a location that can house a full-service branch.

Summary



- Preferred Bank has a strong capital base with 11% tangible common equity
- The Bank repurchased 464,314 shares in 2024 at an average price of \$73.87 and has repurchased 670,047 shares for total consideration of \$53.5 million so far in 2025
- The Bank moved from high asset sensitivity which benefitted the Bank through 2022 and 2023 to a more matched balance sheet which has helped to navigate a declining or sideways rate environment
- ACL coverage is 1.28% of total loans, providing a robust cushion
- Currently trading at 8.4X 2025 consensus earnings
- TSR proves that organic growth and consistent TBV growth equal superior shareholder returns in the banking industry
- Important performance metrics (ROA, ROE, efficiency ratio) are well above peer group
