PotlatchDeltic's business philosophy is grounded in sustainably managing the resources we own, making sound decisions that provide for long-term economic stability and in supporting the communities where we conduct business

Our Forest Stewardship Policy and sustainable forestry program are founded on several key commitments:

- The Company's commitment to the environment is focused on responsible forest stewardship, energy efficiency, waste
 minimization and utilization, pollution prevention, and protection of the health and safety of employees, customers and the
 communities in which we operate
- Renewable forest resources will be conserved and protected to provide an optimum economic rate
 of return to the Company while enhancing water, wildlife and other resource values
- Sustainably manage and perpetually renew our third-party certified forests
- Forest stewardship will be practiced with a high degree of awareness of present and future impacts on the public
- · We will utilize efficiently all human, financial, physical and natural resources
- We will maintain high ethical standards and open, forthright relationships with all stakeholders
- We do not deforest or degrade our forests, managed and verified as sustainable through third-party certification

To meet these commitments, PotlatchDeltic will maintain an environmental management system that supports our Timberland management and our Wood Products business' log procurement activities

The environmental management system at a minimum will ensure that we:

- Conduct all our activities to meet or exceed applicable federal, state, and local statutes and regulations for conservation of wildlife and biological diversity, and protection of water, fish and endangered species
- Reforest harvested areas by planting or planned natural regeneration
- Focus on and emphasize pollution prevention
- Continuously improve the best management practices we utilize in our forests
- Achieve and maintain third-party certification of all of our Timberlands under either the Forest Stewardship Council[®] (FSC[®]) or the Sustainable Forestry Initiative[®] (SFI[®]) management standards
- Achieve and maintain third party certification of our Wood Products log supply chain under the SFI Fiber Sourcing Standard
- Source our Wood Products log supply chain from responsible sources and promote reforestation and natural resource conservation on source lands
- Do not source from lands that have been deforested or degraded as defined by the SFI standard
