The stellar inaugural lineup also includes London Grammar, Alt-J, Pixies, The Roots, Marshmello, Liam Gallagher, The Hives, Martin Solveig, I AM, La Femme and many more, with over 40 artists performing on four stages. Tickets will go on sale Thursday, January 19 at www.LollaParis.com.

Fans will be able to experience all that Lollapalooza has to offer, with a diverse lineup, a wide variety of French cuisine, art exhibitions, and a space dedicated to music fans that want to learn more about how to help the world around them.

Lollapalooza welcomes music fans of all ages, including kids. Kidzapalooza, is a festival within a festival offering parents and kids the opportunity to catch family-friendly music on its own stage plus various activities including creating their own music, arts & crafts and much more. Children ages 10 and under may enter Lollapalooza free of charge, with a ticketed adult.

Lollapalooza is pleased to announce Paris as the latest addition to the expanding global family, joining successful international editions in Chile, Brazil, Argentina and Germany. Lollapalooza celebrated its 25 Anniversary in Chicago in 2016, delivering 170 bands on 8 stages to 400,000 fans over 4 days.

About Lollapalooza:

Launched by founder Perry Farrell in 1991 as a touring festival, Lollapalooza remains an innovator in festival culture 25 years later. Lollapalooza was the first festival to bring together artists from a wide range of musical genres on one bill, it was also the first to travel, the first to expand to multiple days, the first to introduce a second stage, the first to blend art and activism, the first to offset its carbon emissions, the first to put electronic dance music artists on the main stage, the first to create family friendly programming, the first to make its home in an urban city center and the first to expand internationally.

Lollapalooza has grown into an annual world-class festival in Chicago (2005), as well as culturally rich countries including Chile (2011), Brazil (2012), Argentina (2014), Germany (2015), and Paris (2017). Lollapalooza is one of the premier destinations both for music fans in the United States and abroad. In celebration of the festival's 25th Anniversary, Lollapalooza Chicago expanded to four days in 2016, hosted 100,000 fans a day, and featured over 170 artists on 8 stages.

Lollapalooza Paris is produced by Perry Farrell, William Morris Endeavor Entertainment, C3 Presents and Live Nation France.
