JOB PURPOSE

To set up a multiple Boom Jumbo to scale, support and drill in an underground mining development.

ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Assess ground conditions at the face and implement ground controls as per the site requirements.
- Accurately drill the required number of patterns using mechanized electric hydraulic jumbo drill suitable for ground conditions.
- Use the appropriate mining instructions to drill holes to design lines, gradient and profile.
- Optimize drill patterns to ensure that maximum advance per round is achieved whiles maintaining strict adherence to design specifications with minimal over break.
- Ensure that all statutory requirements associated with mining operation are completed in compliance with the Mining Act and related regulations of the Republic of Ghana.
