“This award is truly an honor and reflects our company’s commitment to veterans, reservists and guardsmen,” King said. “Anything we can do as supervisors to help ease their transition between military and civilian roles is a small sacrifice compared to what these men and women provide to our country.”

This is the second time Werner Enterprises has received the Pro Patria Award, and King’s presentation marks the fifth time a member of the Werner team has been recognized with the Patriot Award.
