**Summary:** CPUC Electrical Incident - Property Damage - EI210518A - On June 22, 2021, PG&E Law-Claims received a claim for property damage resulting from a fire that allegedly occurred near the intersection of Dowling Street and 83rd Avenue in Oakland on May 18, 2021. The claim alleges that PG&E equipment may have caused the fire. The property damage value is estimated to exceed \$50,000. The area is served by the Oakland J 1106 12kV Overhead Distribution Circuit. The portion of the circuit at the incident location did not appear to have any outages on the day of the incident. PG&E is reporting this incident under the Property Damage criteria.
